"The Mission to Wimereux...

Mission Synopsis:

WX Poor, but Good Takeoff and form up. Moved into Zone 2 Flying at Low altitude over England. Attacked by Me-110G4 (Novice Pilot failed to sight us) Over the Channel in Zone 3. NF encounter, but got Random Event #5 (Mosquito drives off NF in next Zone. Moved into Zone 4, Crossed French coast at low altitude, AAA guns failed to locate us (No AA Attacks) Located by 1 NF but driven off by Mosquito from Random Event #5 last zone. Bombs On-Tgt. Photo assessment: 20% On Target. Dropped to on-the deck level for egress. Not located by Radar. Not attacks on return flight. Landed Safe.

Senior Erk WO Cartwright advised "Roger" will be ready for the next mission.

20% of the bombs dropped were On Target.
