

After Action Report – Charmed

30 April 1942

Charmed, of 103 Squadron, 15 Group

Mission was as easy as one could hope for. Despite a lot of flak and encountering five enemy fighters there was no appreciable damage, and no injuries.

Tail gunner A. Carr shot down a JU-88 over the North Sea, outbound.

A Mosquito found us on approach to the target, and drove off a 110 that had set its eyes on us.

Bomb run was clean, with 30% on target.

Landing was routine. Charmed's damage was superficial, requiring little more than paint, and she will be ready for the next mission.

If we can locate that Mosquito pilot, dinner is on me.
