

After Action Report – Amorous Amy

28 March 1942

Amorous Amy, of 103 Squadron, 15 Group was reported missing, 27 March 1942.

A search was conducted, along the aircraft's expected route, as far as our search and rescue boats and aircraft could safely go.

Debris was found floating off the Dutch coast. No bodies were found, but some personal effects were discovered, that identified at least one known crewman of the aircraft. The condition of the items suggested a massive explosion.

Reports from a resistance cell, on the Dutch coast, indicated what was assumed to be an aircraft exploding, at about the time the missing aircraft was expected to pass that locality.

It is assumed the aircraft was shot down by enemy aircraft, with loss of the entire crew.
