Well, what we thought was happening has actually happened. The techs have found out that the Germans have been able to home in on our Monica tail warning radar. So a few days ago, all the Monica systems were removed from our bombers. Many are grumbling about this as Monica provided an extra set of eyes watching our 6.

Now, as our ground forces free more and more of Europe from the clutches of the Nazis, we are to do an area bombing attack against Heilbronn in Germany. Apparently, Heilbronn is a major rail hub for the German military.

At 8 pm, we take off and join the bomber stream. The Phantom is bomber number 11 in the tail end of the bomber stream.

The trip over the sea and France, Belgium and Luxembourg is mostly routine and quiet. German night fighter activity has decreased remarkably as we have gained control of the air.

As we fly southwest of Bonn, the Phantom shudders as an Me110 night fighter fires its Jazz Music Cannons int the underbelly of the bomber. Fred Ray, our tail gunner, reports that his heating system has gone out and then lets out a scream; our starboard wing takes a wing root hit; the bombers nose section takes superficial damage; shrapnel hits our flight engineer in the nose causing some superficial bleeding; some holes are poked in the bomb bay doors; our tail gunner doesn't report in after the attack. When checked on, he was found to have bled out. The Me 110 disappears into the night.

As we approach Heilbronn, we see fires in the distance as well as searchlights and the ever-present flak bursts. We line up on the target flairs dropped by the pathfinders. Archie opens the bomb bay doors and drops the load on the target. 50% of the bombs fall on target. We make our turn to the return course.

Our return trip is uneventful but very quiet as we are all dealing with the loss of Fred. A good man who leaves behind a family who loved him and friends who cared about him.
